We investigated, using bar models how fractions become smaller when multiplied and how we can invert fractions when we divide by whole numbers.</p>	<p>Can you demonstrate how we multiply fractions? Divide fractions by whole numbers? Why does the fraction become smaller when you multiply by another fraction?</p>
