We revised our strategies for identifying factors systematically and also how we use our Multiplication tables knowledge in order to assess whether a number is Prime or not.</p>	<p>What is a Prime Number? Is 345 Prime? How do you know? What are the factors of 50?</p>
<p>ENGLISH Reading We are continuing 'Now or Never' discussing vocabulary, completing comprehension questions as well as making connections with our work on WW2. Writing This week we completed our non-chronological reports on Antarctica and started out new text – 'Ice Trap' about the journey Earnest Shackleton made to the Antarctic.
