
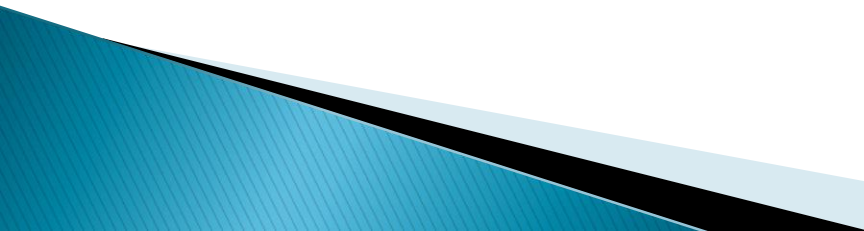

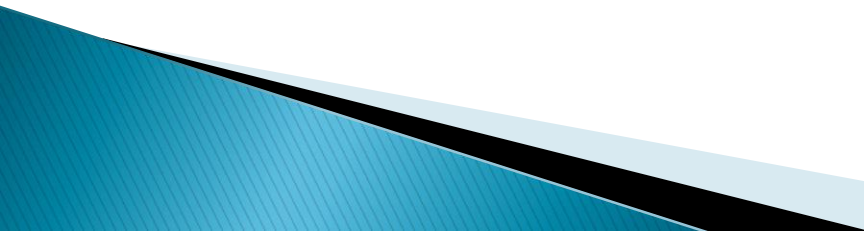
New initiatives

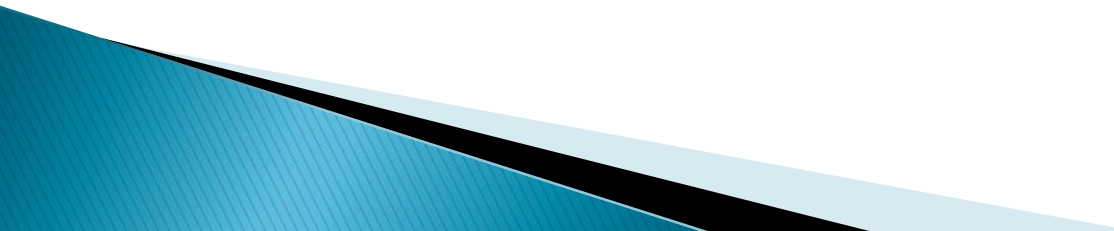
Oracy at Allfarthing:

What the children think great oracy is

- ▶ Plan what you are saying
 - ▶ Use expression
 - ▶ Original ideas
 - ▶ Include others
 - ▶ Engage people in the conversation
 - ▶ Pride in what you are saying
 - ▶ Stand up and use full sentences
 - ▶ Active listening/show you are listening
 - ▶ Engaging your audience
 - ▶ Be confident and clear
 - ▶ Eye contact
 - ▶ Can everyone hear you?
 - ▶ Positive body language
 - ▶ Be enthusiastic/interesting/passionate
 - ▶ Share ideas
 - ▶ Be brave
 - ▶ Respect everyone and use kind language
