	QUESTIONS TO ASK YOUR CHILD (this is to stimulate talk with your child – there is no need for you to write anything down or return the sheet to school)
MATHS This week, we have looked at factors, square numbers and primes. We have also completed an arithmetic test, and a reasoning paper as a progress check.	What are the factors of 36? What else do you know about 36? Is it prime? Square? Composite? Why?
ENGLISH Reading We have continued reading our new text, 'The Eye of the Wolf'. Writing We have written a descriptive narrative from the perspective of Toa the Trader, who has been asked to take care of a baby after the destruction of their African village.	What is your writing target? Did you meet it? What went well?
RE We have focused on Christianity, in particular psalms where we wrote our own Allfarthing ones.	What is a psalm? What did you come up with for your psalm?
PSHE We introduced our Zones of Regulation as a means of identifying and managing our feelings and emotions.	What are the 4 zones? What words could you use in each one?
