MATHS This week, we have looked at multiplying non-unit fractions by whole numbers and finding fractions of amounts using the X symbol.	What does 'x' mean? Solve $\frac{1}{4} \times 60$ Solve $23 \times \frac{1}{4}$
ENGLISH Reading We have enjoyed our new text, 'The Highwayman', a classical narrative poem by Alfred Noyes. This week we are immersing ourselves in the story through text analysis and performance of the poem.	What is a 'highwayman'? Can you summarise the story? What new words did you learn?
TOPIC We have started our new topic focusing on Ancient Greece. We completed our prior knowledge quiz to see what we know and learnt about the location of Ancient Greece.	What do you know about Ancient Greece already? What would you like to find out?
