| | QUESTIONS TO ASK YOUR CHILD (this is to stimulate talk with your child – there is no need for you to write anything down or return the sheet to school) |
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| MATHS This week, we have been looking at how different fractions can be of the same value. For example $\frac{1}{4} = \frac{3}{12}$. | Write 3 other fractions that are equal to $\frac{1}{4}$. Is $\frac{2}{5}$ equal to $\frac{1}{3}$? How do you know? |
| ENGLISH This week we have written an alternative ending to The Highwayman. We were set the challenge of coming up with ideas, writing them as paragraphs and then turning them into poems. We looked carefully at the rhyming pattern so we could replicate that. | What was your alternative ending? What was the rhyming scheme? |
| TOPIC We have started our new topic focusing on Ancient Greece. We compared the life of Spartan men and Athenian men in Ancient Greece. | Would you rather have been Athenian or Spartan? Why? |
| SCIENCE We started 'Earth and Beyond' in science this week. We completed enquiry circles to show what we already know about each statement we were given about space. | What do you know about space? What are the 2 'episodes' we will make going to cover? |
