MATHS Revision this week started with our work on fractions. We revised all areas including the four main operations, simplifying, converting and comparing fractions. We then moved on to Number and Place Value when we worked on success strategies when problem solving.	Can you explain 4 different calculations you can perform involving fractions?
ENGLISH Reading This week we looked at Dealing with Stress, preparing for auditions and planning trips – all important things in Year 6! Writing Continuing with the story of 'Macbeth' we have met his wife! We wrote her diary, imagining what she thought about events and confessed her plan about the future.	What trip did you plan? Which subject was it linked to? What do you think about Lady Macbeth? Why do you think she is one of Shakespeare's most famous characters?
SCIENCE This week we considered animal adaptation. We examined specific animals and their habits and then linked their features to how they had adapted to live in their environment.	How has a Camel adapted to live in the desert?
TOPIC This week we were looking at the Maya belief system. We learned about the different Gods – their roles, how they were represented and how The Mayans believed in the connection between animals and the afterlife.	Explain the Maya god you created. What powers did it have? Was it based on an animal?
