	QUESTIONS TO ASK YOUR CHILD (this is to stimulate talk with your child – there is no need for you to write anything down or return the sheet to school)
MATHS This week, we have continued our work on types of number, focusing on both prime and common factors, as well as common multiples.	What are the first 6 prime numbers? What are the common factors of 24 and 36? What prime factors does 36 have?
ENGLISH Reading We have continued reading our new text, 'The Eye of the Wolf'. Writing We are building up to writing a non-chronological report about deforestation, linking to our text.	What is deforestation? Why is it happening? What are the effects?
ART We have looked at different types of line and the effects from them. We then applied this skill to recreate our own version of Van Gogh's 'Starry Night'.	What lines did you use? What went well? What might you improve next time?
MUSIC This week, we went to Burntwood School to rehearse our Vocal Project concert with other Wandsworth schools.	Which songs went well? Which songs do we need to work on? Why?
