MATHS This we have begun our work on Long division. We started by constructing 'Related facts' to help us with our division and then spent time learning and then practicing the formal written method.	What are 'Related facts' How do they help your division? What is 2535 divided by 15?
ENGLISH Reading We are continuing the journey of Edward Tulane. Disaster has struck and Edward proceeds on his first adventure. Writing In 'Floodland', Zoe has arrived on the island and met some very interesting characters. We wrote panoramic descriptions of the Cathedral where Zoe has been taken.	What happened to Edward on board the ship? Who are his new carers? What is a panorama? Describe the Cathedral.
SCIENCE Our new Science topic is 'Light'. We began by looking up lots of associated vocabulary and then learning about how light travels.	How does light travel? What has reflection to do with it?
